Brigadier Aitken was appointed by Her Majesty the Queen as Lord-Lieutenant of Gwent in March 2016. Previously he was Deputy Lieutenant of Gwent and has lived in Gwent since childhood. Following a choral scholarship to Oxford, Brigadier Aitken was commissioned in the Royal Regiment of Wales. He had a distinguished military

career lasting 34 years during which time he was awarded a CBE.

Selected for the role by the Queen and appointed in March 2022 as the new High Sheriff of Gwent for 2022/23.

The tradition of the high sheriff dates back more than 1,000 years, with 55 High Sheriffs appointed each year. Each year, for each traditional county in Wales, for a year-long term. In the past, these figures had responsibilities such as collecting taxes and judging cases, but in modern times, the High Sheriff is mainly a ceremonial role, promoting voluntary organisations and supporting emergency services, law-enforcement agencies, and religious groups.

The High Sheriff's Award is designed to reward the volunteers, charities and community groups in Gwent who devote their time and energy to improve the communities in which they live and work, to make Gwent a better and safer place.


